2. Approval of the minutes of the last Working Group 10 meeting held on 18th March in Brussels With no further remarks, the minutes of the last WG10 meeting held on 18th March 2014 in Brussels were unanimously approved.

3. Review and approval of document on use cases and requirements

- 3.1. Final review and approval of the ENC use cases and requirements document

 The ENC use cases and the requirement list were updated and merged together. The
 group will review and finalise the document by May 9th. Please refer to the attached
 document "RequirementSpecificationENC V8.docx". This document is the target
 specification for quoting the software solution (see point 4 below).
- 3.2. Review of the requirement list in the excel matrix
 As mentioned in the previous point, the requirement list was merged with the ENC use cases in a single word document.

4. Business Model and Statement of Work for the development of the EGEA Net

Actia and Axonet will evaluate and quote the effort for the development of their respective solutions.

The quotes will be based on the statement of work in this section and on the requirement document mentioned above in 3.1.

Deadlines

Draft quotes are expected by Friday May 23rd.

Final quotes are expected by June 30^{th.}

The Statement of Work was defined as follows:

- Technical specification of the ENC interface, including definition and description of services and data, to allow manufacturers of ENC clients to connect to the EGEA Net
- Technical specification of the ENC server interface
- ENC server software (as source code or in binary format for Windows and Linux)
- Conformance test plan
- Conformance test suite (also as source code)
- Implementation guideline
- Schedule
- Documents will be publicly available (not necessarily free of charge to cover the costs)
- Support to developers of ENC Clients (equipment manufacturers, DMS and PTI application developers), Monday-Friday, 8:00-17:00 CET, in English
- License terms

To be quoted separately:

- Conformance test plan for the ENC server
- Conformance test suite for the ENC server (also as source code)
- Technical specification of the ENC server with details to allow independent development of compliant ENC server
- ENC client platform module for integration in the devices (as binary or as source code in different languages: C#, Java, C)

Not to be quoted at present:

- Connection to the VIP for vehicle PTI data retrieval
- Certification activities

Troubleshooting and support to PTI centers will be responsibility of the equipment manufacturers or PTI application and DMS providers.

5. Liaison with CITA WG 5 and EUCARIS

- 5.1. Mr. Multari presented CITA's WG 5 outcome of the Unisys questionnaire with the view of the CITA members (see documents "WG5_01_2014_012v1_VIP_CITA_VIEWS marked by AM.pdf" and "Update 15 April 2014 on EU RWP marked by AM.pdf" attached). CITA is interested to work together with EGEA WG 10.
- 5.2. A presentation on EUCARIS was also given and showed that this system is already in place in 28 countries (see document "WG5_01_2014_009v1_VIP_ViewsEReg&EUCARIS marked by AM.pdf" attached). EUCARIS is interested to work together with EGEA WG 10.

6. WG10 budget plan and schedule

6.1. A draft budget for WG10 was outlined. It will be updated with the quotes for the development of the solution.

 It was made clear that the EC will not fund the development of the solution: it has to be a business case anyway. Also, the EC will not support or mandate a solution unless it went through a public discussion and a tender issued by the EC.
