Creation of New WG9 on 'MACs'

- The new refrigerant HFO1234yf engendered new specifications and requirements for service stations and test equipment <u>BUT</u> which are not fully underpinned by European standards and not fully aligned for the multibrand aftermarket.
- Decision to create a new WG9 on Mobile Air-Conditioning Systems to address the lack of equipment standardisation for 1234YF servicing equipment for the European market.
- First WG9 meeting took place in Brussels on 6th December 2011.



Results of WG9 meeting

- Discussion on the fact that the German VMs (VDA) created a version of the SAE standards to ensure that there is a clear 1234YF servicing equipment definition for the European dealer networks (product needed to be approved by TUV).
- Discussion on the fact that ASA was assessing the VDA specifications for aftermarket customers, but ASA have now agreed to use the EGEA specification.
- Decision to create an 'EGEA specification' based on VDA specifications, but also to include optional products based on the SAE standards (e.g leak detectors, gas identifiers,...).

Next steps
